

Peter Rabbit™ Posting Game

Setting up

Spread the cards, face down, on the table.

Note: For younger players, place the cards picture side up.



Game One

Place the houses within reach of all players.

The youngest player starts.

Turn over a card and look at the colour. Post the card into the matching coloured house.

Play passes to the next player.

Play continues until all the cards have been posted.



Game Two

Each player chooses a house and places it in front of them.

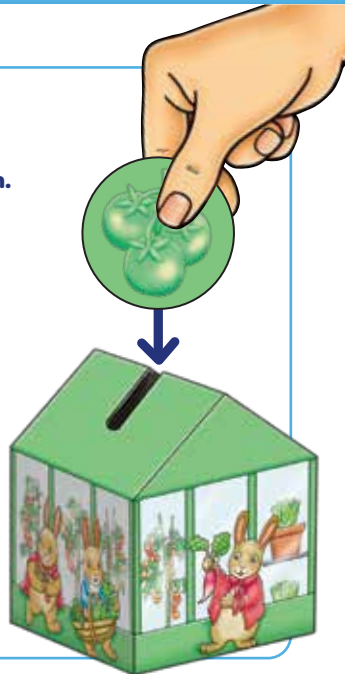
The youngest player starts.

Turn over a card and, if the colour **matches** your house, post the card into the house.

If it **does not match**, return the card face down to the table.

Play passes to the next player.

Play continues until all the cards have been posted.



Game Three

Each player chooses a house and places it in front of them.

This game plays like Game Two, but the game ends when one player has found and posted all six matching coloured cards into their house and wins the game.



More ways to play

Game One can also be played individually as a fun activity to help with colour recognition.
